Vic Tennant was an Edgerton tradesman, musician, supporter and financial contributor to our museum who valued preserving the history of his community and its' people. Vic passed away at Sundre, Alberta on February 7, 2021. To remember and honour Vic, the Edgerton & District Historical Society will award the Vic Tennant Memorial Bursary annually in the amount of \$1,000.00.

The application deadline is **May 31st annually**. The successful applicant will be notified by **June 30th**. The funds will be dispersed by **October 1st** upon proof of payment of tuition.

The eligibility requirements are as follows:

- A current or past resident of Edgerton and District;
- A current or past student of the Edgerton Public School;
- Accepted or attending training in the trades or a course of study at a post-secondary institution;
- Proof of acceptance and payment of tuition fees;
- Evidence of community involvement, volunteerism and good citizenship.
